

# Specifications of the Vinje Organ – February 2004

Built by Reuter Organ Company of Lawrence, Kansas – Installed in 1963 (Opus 1399)

The original organ console was replaced with a 1988-vintage console purchased from St. Michael Lutheran Church (LCMS), Bloomington, MN and installed at Vinje September 16-19, 2002, by David Salmen (of Salmen Organs of South Dakota). Current organ is 24 ranks.

New reed pipes were installed, and the entire organ re-voiced, in February 2004 by David Salmen and Dan Abrahamson (recently retired head reed voicer of Reuter Organ Co.).
